Now click on the storage submene and then on the empty string under the IDE controller. Click on the small CD icon next to the CD/DVD disc list, and select the option, Select a virtual cd/DVD drive file. Scroll through the Windows iso file that you previously downloaded to the actual (rather than virtual) system and download it. Now click on the large OK button at the bottom of the general settings window. Cross your fingers and click on the big Start button to download your virtual machine for the first time. If all went well, the first thing you'll see is an annoying pop-up message telling you about keyboard and mouse capture options. Ignore it.
